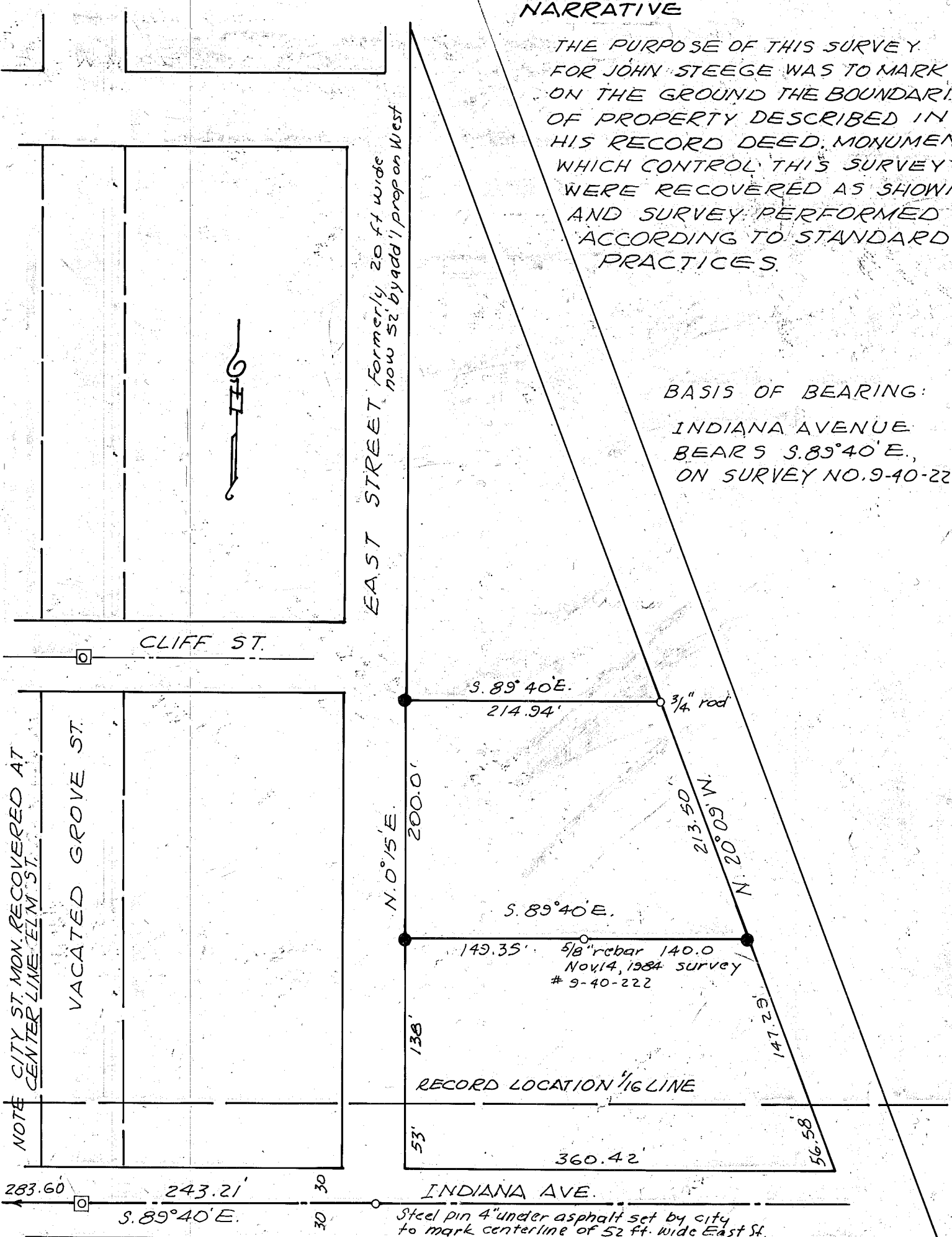


NARRATIVE

MAP OF SURVEY

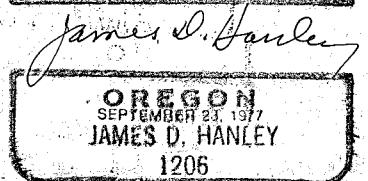
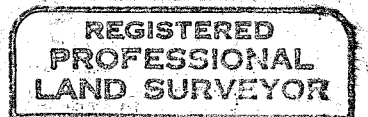
