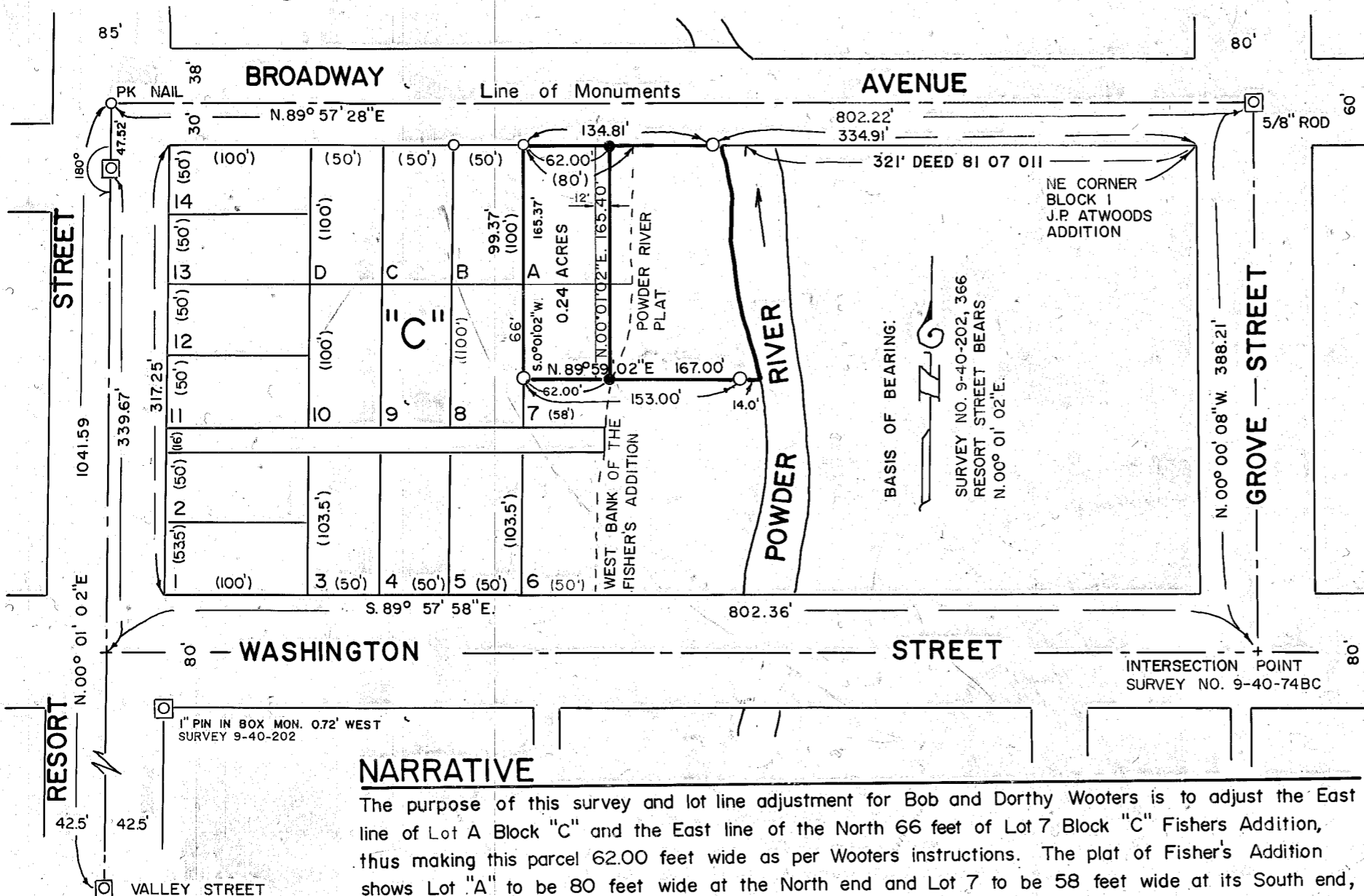


LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT SURVEY

LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT SURVEY IN Block "C" Fisher's Addition

NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey and lot line adjustment for Bob and Dorothy Wooters is to adjust the East line of Lot A Block "C" and the East line of the North 66 feet of Lot 7 Block "C" Fishers Addition, thus making this parcel 62.00 feet wide as per Wooters instructions. The plat of Fisher's Addition shows Lot "A" to be 80 feet wide at the North end and Lot 7 to be 58 feet wide at its South end, both lots terminating at West Bank of the then located Powder River. Deed 81 07 011 describes that land lying East of Lots "A" and "7" and West of the now located Powder River. Monumentation from Baker County Surveys 9-40-74BC, 9-40-202 and 9-40-366 was recovered as shown and held as control for this survey
