NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY FOR LANE AND GAIL POTTER IS TO MARK ON THE GROUND THE CORNERS OF THE PARCEL CONSISTING OF LOTS 9-13 AND ALSO THAT PORTION OF THE EAST HALF OF ALLEY ADJOINING LOT 9, BLOCK 14, STEWART'S SECOND ADDITION. CONTROLLING STREET INTERSECTION MONUMENTS WERE RECOVERED, THE BLOCK TRAVERSED AND 7 PROPERTY CORNER MONUMENTS WERE SET. THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE VACATED ALLEY PORTION OF THE SURVEY COULD NOT BE SET, FALLING IN THE SETTLER'S SLOUGH DITCH. A $\frac{5}{8}$ INCH REBAR WITH CAP PREVIOUSLY SET BY HANLEY ENGINEERING WAS FOUND IN PLACE MARKING THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 9.
