## NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY FOR LANE AND GAIL POTTER IS TO MARK ON THE GROUND THE CORNERS OF THE PARCEL CON-SISTING OF LOTS 9-13 AND ALSO THAT PORTION OF THE EAST HALF OF ALLEY ADJOINING LOT 9, BLOCK 14, STEWARTS SECOND ADDITION CONTROLLING STREET INTERSECTION MONUMENTS WERE RECOVERED. THE BLOCK TRAVERSED AND 5 PROPERTY CORNER MONUMENTS WERE SET. THE SOUTHWEST COR-NER OF THE VACATED ALLEY PORTION OF THE SURVEY COULD NOT BE SET, FALLING IN THE SETTLER'S SLOUGH DITCH. A THINCH REBAR WITH CAP PREVIOUSLY SET BY HANLEY ENGINEER-ING WAS FOUND IN PLACE MARKING THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 9.

STEWARTS 2nd ADDITION


