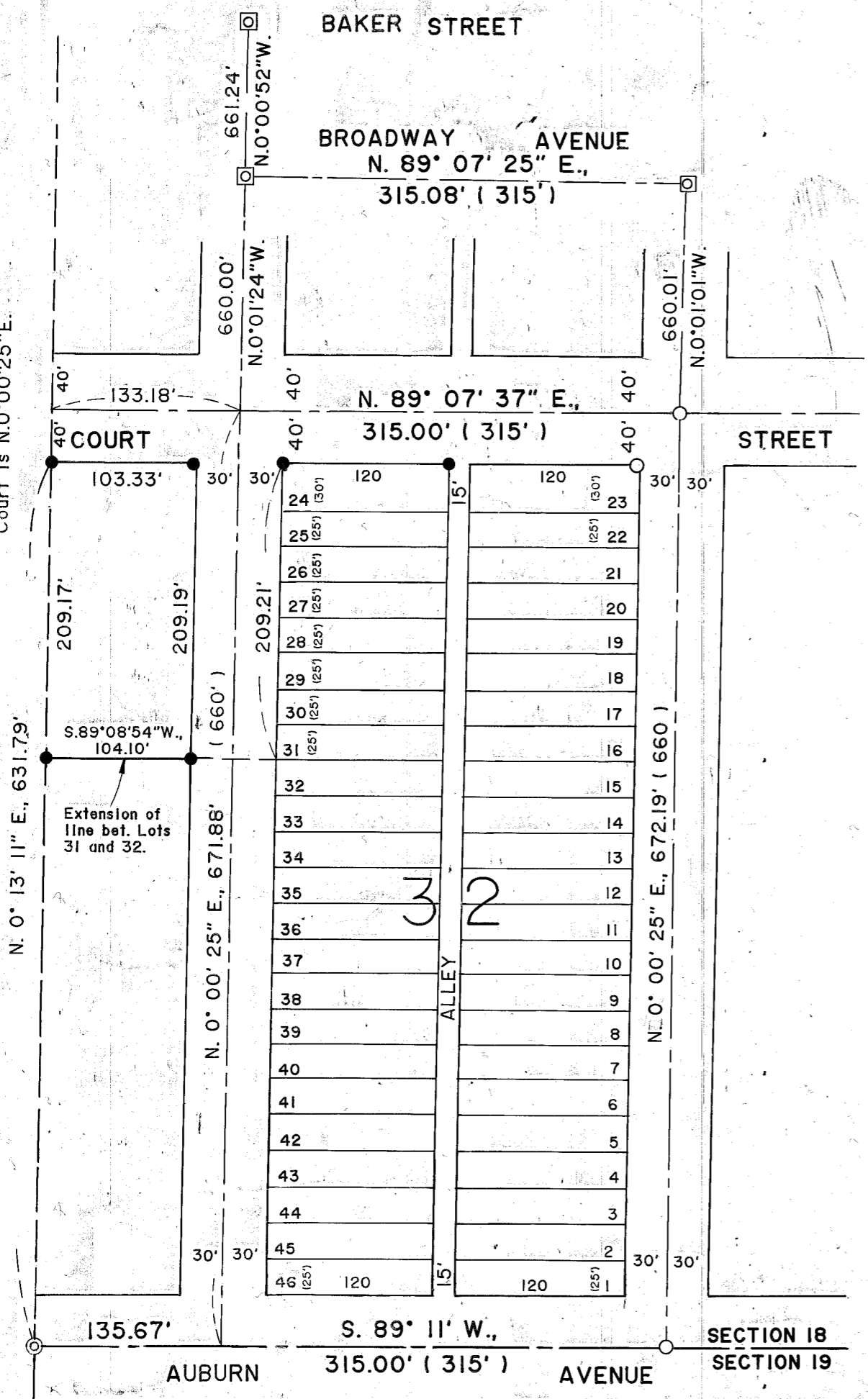


BASIS OF BEARING

SURVEY NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey for Dick and Judy Marr is to monument the corners shown on the annexed map. Existing control at street intersections was recovered from which the North-South lot distances could be proportioned with the excess lengths, according to standard survey practices. The SW corner of the SE1/4 SE1/4 was tied to the Northwest corner of the NE1/4 SE1/4 to determine the bearing between, which is the West line of the subject survey.
