### NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey for Ellingson Timber Co. is to mark on the ground two property lines per the instructions of Rob Ellingson. The first line runs from the Northeast corner of Parcel No. B established by Baker County Survey No. 9-40-486, in a Northeasterly direction to a 40.9 feet offset to the center of the Powder River. This new line adjusts the South line of Parcel No. C established by Baker County Survey No. 9-40-490. The second line runs from the Southeast corner of Parcel No. B, due East to a 68.1 feet offset to the center of the Powder River. Monumentation from Baker County Survey Numbers 9-40-466, 9-40-486, and 9-40-490 was recovered and was held for the basis of this subject survey.
