NARRATIVE

SHOWN HEREON ARE VACATED STREETS AND ALLEYS IN PORTIONS OF JACKSON AND WILOVALE ADDITIONS. STREETS AND BLOCKS ARE SHOWN ACCORDING TO THE PLAT OF JACKSON ADDITION, FILED IN PLAT BOOK 2, PAGE 15, AND THE PLAT OF WILOVALE ADDITION, FILED IN PLAT BOOK 3, PAGE 15 OF BAKER COUNTY RECORDS. THE JACKSON ADDITION PLAT DOES NOT SHOW INDIANA AVENUE CONTINUING ON FROM THE EASTERLY RIGHT OF WAY OF CARY STREET TO THE WESTERLY RIGHT OF WAY OF U.P.R.R.. SAID PLAT SHOWS THE OLD SETTLERS SLOUGH OCCUPYING THIS AREA AS WELL AS THE AREA BETWEEN BLOCKS 1 & 9, AND THE U.P.R.R. RIGHT OF WAY. A C.M. FOSTER MAP TITLED "LANDS BELONGING TO THE JOHN F. JACKSON ESTATE, DATED MARCH 14, 1902, SHOWS A RIGHT OF WAY FOR DITCH 33 FEET WIDE & 907 FEET LONG OCCUPYING THIS AREA. PACIFIC AVENUE IN WILOVALE ADDITION HAS NOT BEEN VACATED. VACATION ORDINANCE NO. 2054, FILED IN BOOK 117, PAGE 168, BOOK 125, PAGE 522, AND BOOK 132, PAGE 350 OF BAKER COUNTY RECORDS STATES THAT THE CITY OF BAKER HAS WATER MAINS LOCATED UPON THE FOLLOWING STREETS AND ALLEYS VACATED BY SAID ORDINANCE: NEVADA AVENUE, MAIN STREET, PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE, AND ALL ALLEYS.
