Baker County Survey No. 9-40-51 states:

Original corner post has been destroyed by farming operations.

Corner postition remonumented as follows:

Found the original stone marking the quarter section corner between Sections 1 and 12 and re-established the section corner by intersecting county road (built on East line of Section 2) with line connecting the southwest corner of Section 2 with the aforesaid quarter section corner.

Set a 2½ inch brass cap on a 1 inch iron pipe 31 inches long and projecting 5 inches out of ground.

Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence found. Monument set by Baker County Survey No. 9-40-51 has been destroyed by farming operations again.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of the corner:

Ties were made to monumentation from Baker County Survey No. 9-40-49 to establish the same basis of bearing as said survey. Corner was reestablished at position as shown on Baker County Survey No. 9-40-49.

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter brass cap on a 1" x 30" galvanized pipe. The cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram.

Corner monument references:

From the corner monument:

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with orange plastic cap marked "REFERENCE MONUMENT" bears N. 16° 52' 18" E., 11.58', set approximately 1' below ground in a North-South running fence line.

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with orange plastic cap marked "REFERENCE MONUMENT" bears S. 24° 32' 41" E., 10.11', set approximately 1' below ground in a North-South running fence line.
