
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established in Survey 9-40-535, filed on June 15, 2001. No separate monument record was filed.

Map of Survey states:

Set 5/8" rebar with plastic cap marked "HANLEY ENGR. PLS 1817"

## Description of corner evidence found:

Corner was apparently removed subsequent to survey by unknown party, (see Baker County Circuit Court Case No. 02-484).

At the time of reestablishment of this corner by survey, I did find the bottom 4 in. of a wooden survey lathe near corner position.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

At the position by survey as shown on Survey No. 9-40-588 :

Set a  $3\ 1/4$  in. dia. alum. cap on a  $2\ 3/8$  in. dia. by 30 in. long alum. post, buried 24 ins. in the ground. Placed a rock collar around monument.

Marked as shown:

A 1 1/2 in. dia. alum. cap marking O.S.H.D. ROW, bears N 21 03 39 E, 168.81 ft. dist. in a fence "T" N-S-W.

Cap is not marked, nearby paddle marked: EQ P.O.T. L 2266+18.78 BK 600' RT, and also marked P.S. WB 106+93.37 AH 20 LT, P.O.T. EB 106+93.37 20 RT.

A 1 1/2 in. dia. alum. cap marking O.S.H.D. Backsight point bears S 80°26'09" E, 380.49 ft. dist. 4 ft. E'ly of N-S fence.

Cap is not marked, nearby paddle marked: P.O.T. B 109+50.00 Backsight.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented as described on February 3, 2004 and accessories taken with a total station, using Grid bearing, North Zone of Oregon Coordinate System as shown on Survey 9-40-588.
