
PARTITION PLAT No. P2004-013

A PARCEL OF LAND SITUATED IN THE SE1/4SW1/4
OF SECTION 21, T9S, R40E, WM, BAKER COUNTY, OREGON



NARRATIVE

The purpose of this partition plat is to divide a parcel described in Deed No. 97 14 092 in the SE1/4SW1/4 of Section 21, T9S, R40E, WM, Baker City, Baker County, Oregon, into two parcels. The plat was made at the request of Lauri Woodworth.

This parcel is adjacent to US Highway 30 in Wilovale Addition of the City of Baker City, but all the streets and alleys have been vacated in this vicinity. In general, parcels being created in this area do not reflect the underlying lots and blocks, therefore it is my opinion that at least a portion of the Wilovale Addition should be vacated so as to not have the subdivision causing mapping or deeding problems.

I found two No. 5 rebar monuments on the Southeast side of the parcel being partition, but I did not find any survey of record by which they were established. The distances and bearings between the monuments compared very favorably with the deed calls. One monument had a deteriorating yellow plastic cap that was barely legible with PLS 645. I have assumed that both rebars were set by Jim Hambleton, PLS 645, but the cap is gone from the one located in the paved driveway.

CERTIFICATE

I, Leland Lee Myers, a Professional Land Surveyor registered in the State of Oregon, 587 E Auburn Street, PO Box 99, Sumpter, Oregon 97877, completed this survey on July 16, 2004, by setting the monuments as shown and do hereby certify that the information shown on this plat is in accordance with City of Baker City regulations and ORS Chapter 92 and is correct to the best of my knowledge.

The partitioned parcel in the SE1/4SW1/4 of Section 21, T9S, R40E, WM, Baker City, Baker County, Oregon, is more fully described as beginning at a 2 1/2" Brass Cap on a 1" galvanized pipe which is the quarter corner between Sections 21 and 28; thence N39°41'23"W a distance of 1393.28' to a No. 5 Rebar with no markings on the Northeast right-of-way line of Oregon State Highway No. 30 which is the true point of beginning; thence N47°50'00"W along the said right-of-way line a distance of 311.64' to a 1/2" iron pipe; thence N42°10'00"E a distance of 200.00' to a 3/4" iron pipe; thence S57°58'20"E a distance of 321.00' to a No. 5 Rebar with a deteriorating yellow plastic cap marked PLS 645; thence S43°08'15"W a distance of 256.54' to the true point of beginning, containing 1.65 acres.
