 Land located in the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 20, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, Willamette Meridian, Baker City, Oregon, being a portion of Lot 9 of Highland Crest Subdivision, and also being Parcel No. 2 of Baker County Partition Plat No. P1998-001, plus a portion of vacated 17th Street, the exterior boundary of which is described as follows:

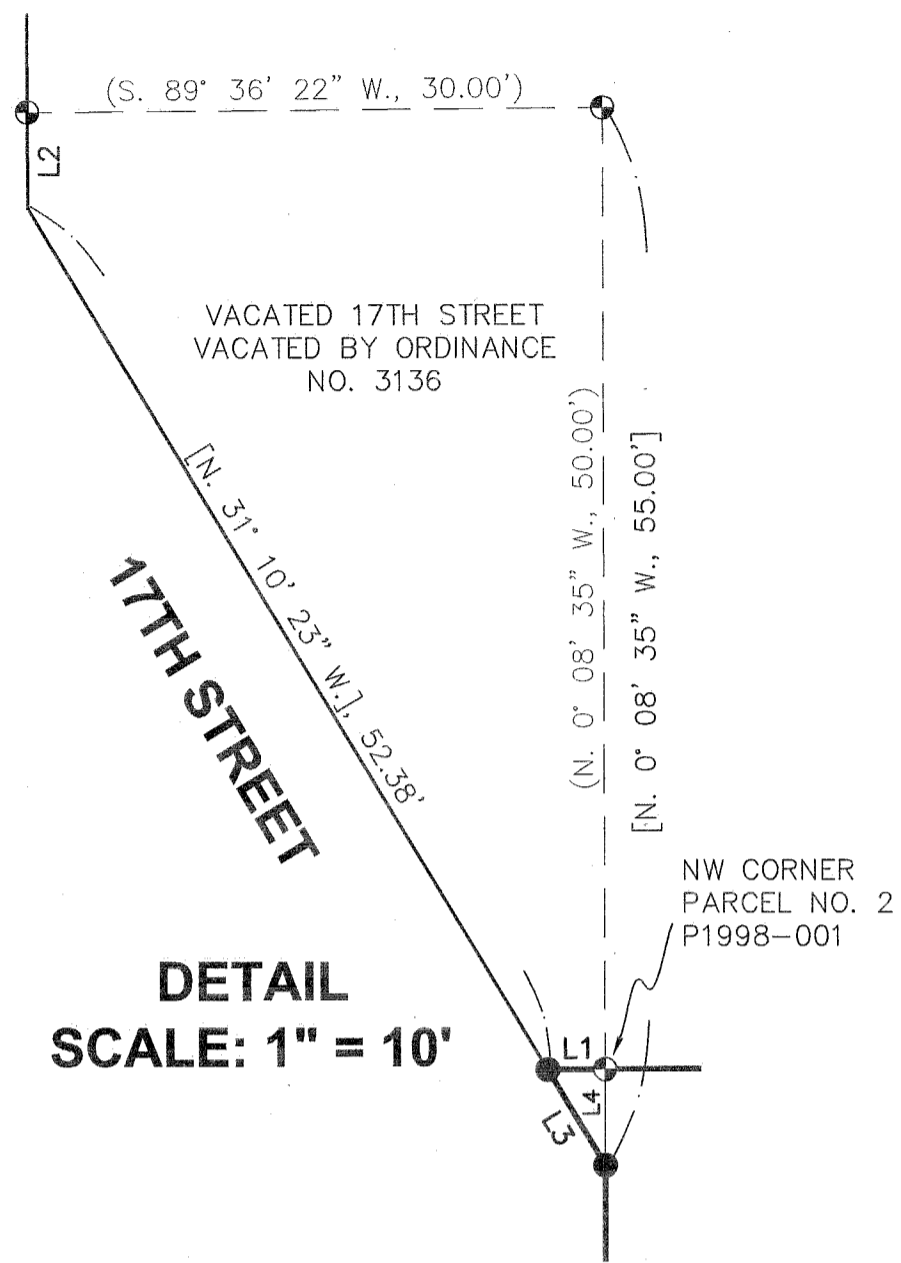
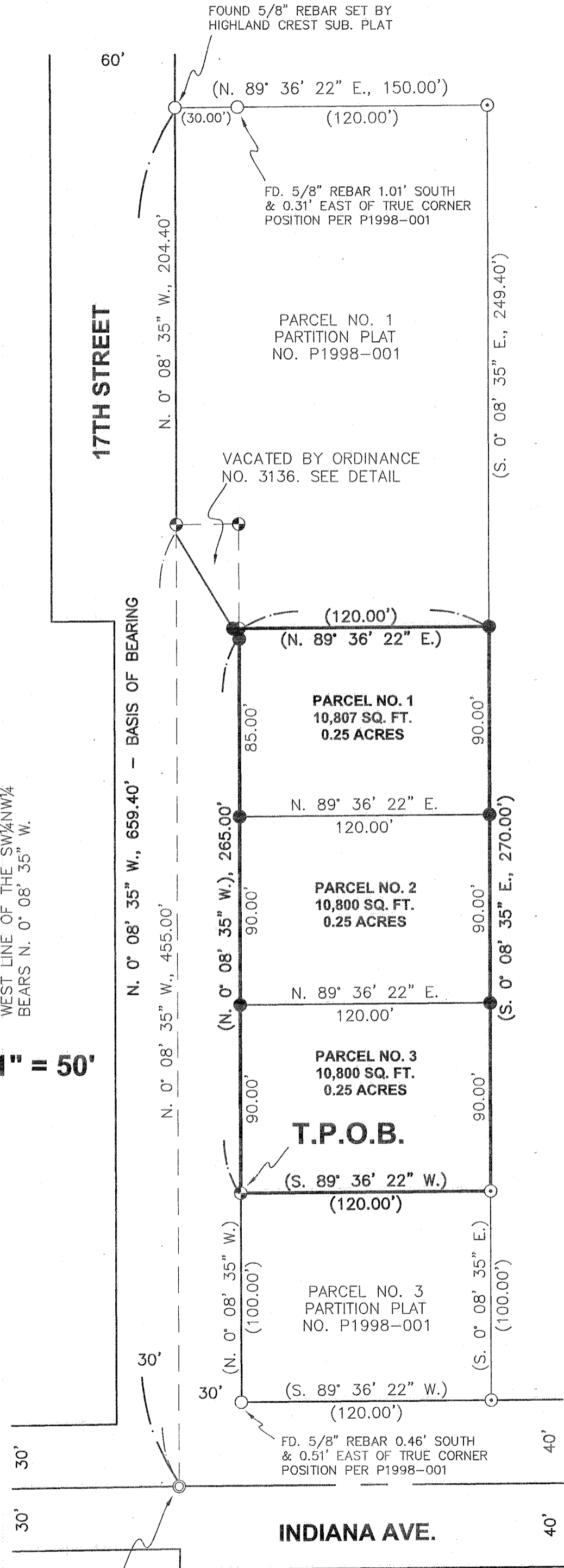
