The purpose of this survey for Ed Elms is to mark upon the ground with proper monumentation the certain corners of his property in Blocks 5 & 7, McCrary's Addition as shown hereon. Monumentation shown on Baker County Survey Numbers 9-40-61BC and 9-40-183 was recovered and held as the basis of bearing as shown hereon. Bearings for Myrtle and Grace Streets between Fifth and Sixth Streets as well as 5th Street between Myrtle and Grace Streets are not calculable with the information supplied on said Baker County Survey Numbers 9-40-61BC and 9-40-183. Bearings shown hereon for these streets are from private file worksheets for the subject projects.
