

RECOVERED THREE IRON PIPE MONUMENTS SET BY STOCKMAN, AND USED THE STOCKMAN MAP AS A BASIS FOR HIS SURVEY

OF THE TASTY BAKE PROPERTY. AFTER SEARCHING UNSUCCESSFULLY IN CITY AND COUNTY RECORDS. I WAS PROVIDED A COPY

FIELD MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE TO RECOVER BAKER CITY CENTERLINE MONUMENTS AT CONTROLLING STREET INTERSECTIONS, AS SHOWN HEREON. I ALSO RECOVERED STOCKMAN'S 3/4" IRON PIPE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF BLOCK 5, WHICH WAS FOUND UNDISTURBED AND WAS HELD FOR THIS SURVEY. I FOUND THE 5/8" IRON PIN SET BY MR. HANLEY AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF BLOCK 5. THE TOP OF THE PIN WAS BENT SIGNIFICANTLY, BUT THE BASE WAS STILL IN POSITION. I

STRAIGHTENED THE PIN AND RESET IT DURING THIS SURVEY. I SEARCHED FOR THE OTHER TWO 5/8" PINS SET AT THE

NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST CORNERS OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY, BUT FOUND NO TRACE OF THEM POSSIBLY DUE TO

I ALSO SEARCHED FOR BUT DID NOT FIND THE MONUMENTS SHOWN ON MAP OF SURVEY NO. 9-40-608SD AT THE NORTHEAST

NEW MONUMENTS WERE SET AT THE NORTHWEST AND NORTHEAST CORNERS OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY ACCORDING TO THE EVIDENCE FOUND AND THE RECORD DIMENSIONS FROM SURVEY NO. 9-40-331 AND THE UNRECORDED STOCKMAN MAP, AS






## BASIS OF BEARINGS

- FOUND BENT 5/8" IRON PIN WITH NO CAP FROM RECORD SURVEY NO. 9-40-331. PIN STRAIGHTENED AND RESET THIS
- FOUND 3/4" IRON PIPE RECOVERED IN RECORD SURVEY NO. 9-40-331
- SET 5/8"X30" IRON PIN WITH ATTACHED YELLOW PLASTIC CAP MARKED "BENCHMARK SURVEYING"
- SET 5/8"X12" IRON PIN WITH ATTACHED YELLOW PLASTIC CAP MARKED "BENCHMARK SURVEYING" (PIN CUT SHORT TO AVOID SEWER LINE)
