

EVIDENCE FOUND: There has been substantial movement of the Powder River channel in this area since 1864. The position falls in a pasture, and there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. I declare this corner lost, and reestablish its position at proportionate measure between the found monuments at the southeast and northeast corners of Section 29.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

At the corner point, as determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached 3" aluminum cap 31" in the ground. Cap is marked as shown below.

From which, I SET THE FOLLOWING REFERENCE POINTS:

- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.45°21'E., 17.92 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.
- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.44°44'E., 17.96 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.
- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.44°49'W., 17.99 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.
- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.45°22'W., 9.97 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.
