


RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

CORNER: NORTHWEST CORNER SEC. 3, TWP. 9 S., RANGE 40 E., W.M.

ORIGINAL SURVEY BY: Timothy W. Davenport, U.S. Deputy Surveyor

CONTRACT NUMBER: 102

CONTRACT DATE: July 20, 1863



ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION: Set post corner to Secs 3, 4, 33 & 34 made mound of earth and drove charred stake per inst.


EVIDENCE FOUND: I found no remaining evidence of the post or earth mound. The corner is determined to be at the corner of long-established fences running North, South West, which is the best available evidence of the original corner location. This position is harmoniously related to other known corners in the area. I also found an unrecorded 5/8" iron pin with attached orange plastic cap marked "REFERENCE MONUMENT", which bears S06°29'E 16.08 feet from the section corner. After making an inquiry to the County Surveyor's office, it was determined to have been set by Hanley Engineering as a reference to the same corner. Mr. Hanley confirmed that although a reference was set, the Section corner itself had not been monumented.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

At the corner point, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached 2½" aluminum cap 34" in the ground. Cap is marked as shown below.

From which, I SET THE FOLLOWING REFERENCE POINTS:

- A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.72°51'E., 29.77 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.
- A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.89°40'W., 46.59 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING, set in an East-West fence.
- A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.00°33'W., 41.32 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING, set in a North-South fence.



I ALSO UTILIZE THE FOUND UNRECORDED REFERENCE POINT:

- A 5/8" iron pin with orange plastic cap marked "REFERENCE MONUMENT" set by Hanley Engineering bears S.06°29'E., 16.08 ft.

Used RTK GPS to measure the reference points. Bearings are based on Baker County Survey No. 8-40-26.


