LEGEND

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF MICHAEL COUNTS, ON BEHALF OF JEAN MULCAHY. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MONUMENT THE CORNERS OF THAT CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED IN INSTRUMENT NO. B17280044, DEED RECORDS OF BAKER COUNTY. SAID TRACT IS COMPRISED OF PORTIONS OF LOTS 4 AND 5 IN BLOCK "L" OF M.E. PLACE'S ADDITION TO BAKER CITY.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. M.E. PLACE'S ADDITION WAS SURVEYED AND PLATTED BY C.M. FOSTER, FILED FEBRUARY 17, 1873. A SEARCH OF THE AVAILABLE COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDS PRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RELEVANT SURVEYS: 9-40-14BC, 9-40-186, 9-40-187, 9-40-556, 9-40-684, 9-40-738 AND 9-40-739.

FIELD MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE TO RECOVER CONTROLLING CENTERLINE MONUMENTS FROM THE AFOREMENTIONED SURVEYS, WHICH WERE ALL ACCEPTED. I FOUND A 1/2" IRON PIPE OF UNKNOWN ORIGIN NEAR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTH HALF OF LOT 2, WHICH WAS ALSO RECOVERED IN SURVEY NO. 9-40-738. THE PIPE IS 0.25 FT. NORTH AND 0.25 FT. EAST OF THE CORNER. I FIND NO RECORD OF THIS PIPE BEING SET BY A SURVEYOR, AND IT IS NOT ACCEPTED FOR THIS SURVEY.

I PROJECTED THE MEASURED BEARINGS OF CARTER STREET AND FIRST STREET TO INTERSECT THE CENTERLINE OF DEWEY AVENUE. THE LOTS WITHIN BLOCK "L" WERE PROPORTIONED ACCORDING TO STANDARD SURVEY PROCEDURES, AS PER THE ORIGINAL PLAT. NEW MONUMENTS WERE SET ACCORDING TO THE EVIDENCE FOUND, AS SHOWN HERFON.

THERE WERE TWO ENCROACHMENTS DISCOVERED AS A RESULT OF THIS SURVEY. A WOODEN FENCE ENCROACHES 6 FEET ACROSS THE SOUTH LINE OF THE MULCAHY PROPERTY, AND THE SHED ON THE MULCAHY PROPERTY ENCROACHES AS MUCH AS 1 FOOT INTO THE ALLEY.
