



BASIS OF BEARINGS

RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 10-44-2 THE SOUTH LINE OF THE SW1/4 SECTION 16 BETWEEN FOUND MONUMENTS BEARS N89'40'58"W, AS SHOWN

NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF CHARLIE VAUGHAN ON BEHALF OF FRED AND JEFF PHILLIPS OF PHILLIPS RANCH. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO LOCATE AND MONUMENT A PROPOSED PROPERTY LINE ADJUSTMENT.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE SURVEY RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. FIELD MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE TO LOCATE THREE OF THE MONUMENTS FROM THE 1965 SURVEY BY THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT UNDER GROUP NO. 262. IN 2001, RICHARD SHAVER, PLS, PERFORMED COUNTY SURVEY NO. 10-44-2. AS PART OF HIS SURVEY, MR. SHAVER RETRACED THE PORTION OF THE 1965 BLM SURVEY ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 16. THE BEARINGS FOR MY SURVEY ARE BASED ON SURVEY NO. 10-44-2 BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER AND THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 16.

I RECOVERED THE ORIGINAL MONUMENT AT THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 9 S. AND 10 S. RANGES 43 E. AND 44 E., WHICH WAS A MARKED STONE SET BY U.S. DEPUTY N.O. WALDEN UNDER CONTRACT NO. 198, DATED JULY 15, 1873. I ALSO FOUND AN UNRECORDED 1/2"X40" GALVANIZED IRON PIPE DRIVEN ALONGSIDE THE MARKED STONE. I REMONUMENTED THIS CORNER WITH A BRASS CAP. SEE CORNER MONUMENTATION SHEET FILED SEPARATELY FOR DETAILS REGARDING THIS MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED.

THE NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY PORTIONS OF THE PROPOSED ADJUSTED LINE GENERALLY FOLLOW AN EXISTING FENCE LINE, AND WERE REQUIRED TO BE SURVEYED. AT THE DIRECTION OF FRED PHILLIPS, THESE PORTIONS OF THE LINE WERE MONUMENTED IN SUCH A WAY SO AS TO MINIMIZE THE NUMBER OF ANGLE POINTS ALONG THE LINE. MONUMENTS WERE SET EITHER ALONG THE FENCE LINE ITSELF OR AT PROJECTED FENCE LINE INTERSECTIONS. THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE PROPOSED LINE FOLLOWS THE CENTER OF LAWRENCE CREEK, WHICH WAS NOT SURVEYED.

THE LOCATION AND ALIGNMENT OF LAWRENCE CREEK AS DEPICTED HEREON IS APPROXIMATE. ALL UNSURVEYED SECTION AND SECTION SUBDIVISION LINES SHOWN HEREON ARE ALSO APPROXIMATE, AND ARE PROTRACTED FOR GENERAL PURPOSES ONLY.
