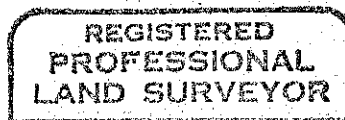


SURVEY NARRATIVE

to accompany Survey No. 9-45-37
of a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T 9 S, R 45 E, W.M.

This survey was performed at the request of U. S. National Bank for the purpose of monumenting that parcel of land described and recorded in Book 166 at Page 240 of the Baker County Deeds. The point of beginning of the above noted deed description is "...30 feet West and 315 feet North of the Southeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$..." and all bearings around the parcel are cardinal directions. For the purpose of this survey, the North and South cardinal directions are interpreted to be parallel to the East line of the said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$. Similarly, the East and West cardinal directions are interpreted to be parallel to the South line of the said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$. The "VICINITY MAP" portion of the accompanying map of survey shows the subdivision of Section 23.
