The description contained in the said deed film volume was found to be inaccurate and erroneous and this narrative and accompanying map of survey show a true representation of the research and deliberations performed. The results of chain of title examination are listed below with references to Baker County Deeds...Book and Page or film volume:

Book 156 Page 584..patent to north 60 rods of west 26 2/3 rods of NW4SW4 said Section 24 established to single ownership, area 10 acres, includes OSHD right-of-way.

Book 158 Page 616 AND Book 159 Pages 332 & 333..establish 1-acre parcel in NE4 of 10-acre parcel, excluding OSHD right-of-way, described fully in film volume 76-04-016.

Film volume 79-43-095. easement description, believed to be identical to that description referred to in film volume 79-34-054, memorandum of sale, but not included with document, which recognized two separate and complete ownerships of original 10-acre parcel and excludes OSHD right-of-way.

....To this point, there are no title ambiguities regards the two separate and complete ownerships originally under one ownership and, although not by formal document, the OSHD right-of-way width of 30 feet has been provided for.

Film volume 84-13-060 AND 85-49-002. warranty deeds with erroneously reconstructed descriptions intended to formalize transfer of ownership of property correctly described in Baker County Deeds film volume 79-43-095.

The boundary established by this survey shows dependence on descriptions found in Baker County Deeds film volume 76-04-016 and 79-43-095 and is in harmony with existing culture and
