

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by W. B. Barr under contract #355 dated June 14, 1880. His record reads Set a post for 1/4 section cor. from which: A 4" Alder bears N15°W, 76 lks., A 4" Alder bears N22°E, 113 lks.. Record surveys 9-45-17 and 9-45-37 held a fence intersection as the corner.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)
Portions of fence lines running North, South, and East. The actual corner point falls in the irrigation canal.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 1" x 24" iron rebar with a 2" Aluminum cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the projected intersection of the fences. This position was verified by distances to corners as seen on County Survey 9-45-37.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N02°17'53"E, 160.64 feet, under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S87°26'58"E, 106.24 feet, under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S87°44'48"E, 167.36 feet, under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S00°05'57"W, 114.89 feet, under the existing fence;
