
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Set a quartz stone 20x12x8 ins. 15 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; from which A tamarack 24 ins. diam. bears N. 10° E. 38 lks. dist. marked & S., B.T. A fir 20 ins. diam. bears N. 30° E. 12 lks. dist. marked & S., B.T.



Description of corner evidence found:

The stone had been moved by wood cutters. The western larch BT is now a stump with the blaze and scribing still on it. The white fir BT has grown to 32" and has grown over the blaze and scribing.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

> Replaced the stone with the aid of the BT's and the hole from which the rock had been removed. Set a 2" aluminum pap on a 1"x30" galvanized pipe, which is split for 8", on the north side of the stone. Attached Bearing Tree tags to the BT's with the following information;

32" WF
