
History of original corner establishment:

T. 10 S., R. 35 E., W.M., bears S. 40 40' W. 17.0 ft. blazed and scribed Clifton 1--554 B.T.



Description of corner evidence found:

The bearing tree and all other evidence of this corner had been obliterated, apparently by a forest fire many years ago.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

This corner was re-established using the \(\frac{1}{4}\) Section Corner tie and proportioning the original distances between cofners. Set a 2" aluminum cap on a 1"x30" galvanized pipe, which is split for 8", for the corner.
