
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

A red fir post 3½ long, 4" square, set 18" in the ground with mound of stones, scribed A No. 1-4-546 whence A red fir 10" diam. bears N. 74° 45' W. 73.72 ft. A red fir 12" diam. bears S. 53° 15'E. 38.30 ft. Each blazed and scribed B.T. A. No. 1-4-546.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone mound about 4° in diameter and 2° high with a portion of the original 4x4 post in the mound. The SE BT is dead and leaning against a rock outcropping. The other BT is in good condition.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set a 2" aluminum cap on a 1"x30" galvanized pipe, which is split for 8", in the center of the rock mound. Placed a Bearing Tree tag on the NW BT which is a 16" D. fir with the information listed above for said tree. The line between corners 3 & 4 of this survey is impassable due to a high rock bluff.
