CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established in 1904 by August W. Mohr deputy Mineral Surveyor.

A post 6 in. sq. 3 ft. long set 18 in. in ground with raised mound of earth and scribed 11-555 HF from which:

a fir 24 in. dia. bears N 78 E, 2.4 ft. scribed 11-555 HF BT.

a fir 24 in. dia. bears N 87 W, 28 ft. scribed 11-555 HF BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

At corner location I found both bearing trees alive and in good condition but no evidence of post or mound as ground is steep.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

As the evidence I found agrees with the original survey, I set a 36 in. long, 2 in. galv iron pipe with 2 in. brass cap in the ground with a mound of stone. Cap marked as shown in diagram.

Set no new bearing trees.

I hereby certify the above corner monument was re-established as herein above, in October 1973.
