
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Herman D. Gradon under GLO contract No. 416, during October, 1881.

The corner was remonumented by L. Myers in 1972.

In September, 1980, under U. S. F. S. contract I was engaged to bring the corner up to U. S. F. S. standards.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found Aluminum Cap on 1 1/4" galvanized pipe projecting 8" above the ground and stamped: Date on the cap, pointing north.

ORLS 699 S10 1/4 S15 Μ 1972

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E, I perpetuate the corner by adding:

9" tamarac, bears N59°E, 22.8 ft. scribed 1/4 S10 BT.

14" tamarac, bears S50°W, 43.2 ft. scribed 1/4 S15 BT.
Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s, and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on the BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-3 on a steel fence post 5' N48°W and 54-2 on a steel fence post 5' S49°E, from the corner.
