
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. R-15

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Herman D. Gradon under G.L.O. contract No 416 during October, 1881. Surveyor General's notes state: "Set a post 3 1/2 ft. long, 3 ins. square 24 ins. in hte ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4S on N. face; from which: A fir 12 ins. diam. bears N55°E, 14 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT. A fir 14 ins. diam. bears S15°E, 46 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT."



## Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2 1/2" square wood post, 12" not rotten and 7 rotten inches in the ground and rotten wood 24" in the ground and pointed tip. From which: A 24" White Fir bears N63°E, 9.5 ft. with grown over blaze. A 32" White Fir bears S18°E, 30.5 ft. with opened blaze and scribed BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

T10S R35E S22 1/4 <del>(</del> S27 OR PLS 1051 1980

At the center of the above described point, set 2 1/2" X 30" glavanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 26" in the ground. No rock in the area.

From which by magnetic declination on N20°E:

An 18" tamarac bears S53°E, 38.9 ft. scribed 1/4S27 BT. Placed 54-3, 54-4 and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-2 nad 54-4 on steel fence post 5' East and 54-2 on steel fence post 5' North of the corner.
