
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. V-23

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Herman D. Gradon under G.L.O. contract No. 416 during October, 1881.

Surveyor General's notes state: "Set a post 3 1/2 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4S on N face; from which: A Tamarack 6 ins. diam. bears N4O°E, 14 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT. A tamarack 14 ins. diam. bears S6O°E, 33 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT."



Description of corner evidence found:

Found down and rotten 16" tamarac scribed 1/4S BT. Measured N60°W, 21.7 ft. and found rotten wood going vertical in the ground for about 12" from which a down and rotten tamarac stump hole bears N70°E, 9.0 ft.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

S25 1/4 - t S36 OR PLS 1051 1980

Tlos R35E

At the center of the above point, set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground. No rock in the area.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E: A 16" tamarae bears N12°W, 78.7 ft. scribed 1/4S25 BT. A 9" White Fir bears S29°W, 19.1 ft. scribed 1/4S36 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PLS1051 on BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' West and 54-2 on steel fence post 5' South of the corner.
