
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was never originally established.



## Description of corner evidence found:

None - corner never established.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the surveved corner location, I set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" alum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{5}$ " alum cap, marked as shown, 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stone from which:

A 9" white fir bears N 19 $^{\circ}$ W -34 $^{\frac{4}{5}}$ ft. A 13" white fir bears N 14 $^{\frac{1}{5}}$ °E -25 $^{\frac{4}{5}}$ ft.

Each blazed and scribed "INTEX-552-563 BT."

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the blaze. Attached sign 54-9 amd 54-3 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on forest boundary south of corner and attached sign 54-2 to both posts and sign 54-9 to one post.

Used steel tape and magnetic staff compass with 20° East declination; measured to center of bearing trees.

This corner was monumented on July 6, 1983.
