CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Ira L. Hoffman under Mineral Survey No. 552, surveyed from September 25 through September 27, 1903. The original notes state that at the corner a 4' long x 5" square pine post was set 18" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which"

DIAGRAM Ophir Cor. 6 (O) MS 552

A 8" pine bears N3 25 E-12.2! marked Ophir 6-552-BT. A 8" pine bears N41°20'W-25.8' marked Ophir 6-552-BT.

This corner was remonumented by Leland Myers in 1972.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 2½" alum cap on 1"x30" flanged pipe protruding 18" from the ground from which"

A 14" dead 1.p. pine bears $N3^{10}_{2}E-12.5!$ w/healed blaze (originaly bearing tree) A 11" dead 1.p. pine bears $N41^{10}_{2}W-26.1!$ w/scribing visable on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree).

NOTE: Myers had set his monument in the hole containing the original rotted wood post. This resulted in Myers monument being very unstable.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

A $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" alum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " alum cap was set 24" in the ground and surrounded with amound of stone from which;

A 7" w. fir bears $N52\frac{1}{2}$ °W-17.0' scribed 0-6-552-BT. A 13" w. larch bears N73°E-17.2' scribed 0-6-552-BT.

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red ring around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on national forcat boundary lines 2.51 and 570 forest boundary lines 3-5' away from corner with signs 54-2 and 54-9 attached to one post and sign 54-2 attached to the other post.

Used steel tape and magnetic staff compass with 20° Edeclination. Meaning the staff compass with 20° Edeclination. to center of bearing trees.

This corner was monumented on June 16, 1983.
