CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey 339 during September 1897. The original notes state that at the corner a 4' long by "square marked pine post was set 18" in the ground and surrounded by a mound of stone from which:

A 10" b. pine bears S28°20'E-19.3' marked D.D. -3-339-BT.

A 12" b. pine bears S85°50'W-41.4' marked D.D.-3-339-BT.

A 12" b. pine bears N25°W-39.3' marked D.D.-3-339-BT. In January 1904, this corner was established as Corner No. 1 of the Aerial and Phoenix Lodes by Arthur Philbrick under MS 546. These original notes state that at the corner a 3½" long by 4" square marked pine post was set 18" in the ground and surrounded by a mound of stone from which:

A 20" black pine bears N35°30'W-57.0' marked BT P-1-546 & BT-A-1-546.

A 20" tamarack bears S18°14'E-30.74' marked BT P-1-546 & BT-A-546.

This corner was remonumented by Leland Myers in 1972.

Description of corner evidence found:

A $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1" galv. iron pipe protruding 12" from a mound of stones from which: A 20" tamarack stump bears S18°E-31.0' marked 1-A1-546 X.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

We added rocks to the existing monument mound to stabilize corner. From Myer's monument:

A 10" r. fir bears N86°W-19.5' scribed DD-3-339-P-1-A-1-546 BT. A 10" r. fir bears N67°E-9.2' scribed DD-3-X-P-1-A-1- X BT.

Each new hearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on national forest boundary northwest and southeast of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and magnetic staff compass with $20^{\rm O}$ east declination. Measured to center of bearing trees.


