

original location of this corner: At the intersect point of the west line of Parcel A and line 4-5 of Mineral Survey No. 458, Greenhorn Lode, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 3" brass cap attached 22" into the ground in a mound of stone. Brass cap is marked:

A 6" western larch bears S70°W, 13.9 ft. scribed "X BT" on a single blaze.
A 7" lodgepole pine bears N44°30'W, 21.1 ft. scribed "X BT" on a single blaze.

PLS 1636 1984

I nailed a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", flush on the lower portion of each bearing tree blaze.

Each bearing tree has a 54-3 and a 54-4 sign attached.
