NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Jeff Cooper. The purpose of this survey was to locate the boundaries of Mr. Cooper's property.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey and field measurements were made to locate the monuments from Survey No. 10-35-225 on the easterly line of Lots 4 and 9. Several monuments from Survey No. 10-35-226 were also located. The monuments on the easterly boundary were accepted and the SE corner of Mr. Cooper's property was established on the line extended to the southerly side line of Resort Street, which has been vacated. I accepted the monuments shown to position Worley Street and Miller Street. The NW corner of Mr. Cooper's property was set on the southerly side line of Worley Street and on the center line of Miller Street, which has been vacated.
