

Found a 2 ins. diam. iron post with a 2 ins. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown, projecting 6 ins. above ground, firmly set, with a rock collar.

A deteriorated pine stump, bears N. 48° E., 37.0 ft. dist., with pine remains.

A stump hole, bears S. 18° E., 36.4 ft. dist., with pine remains. (S. 20° E., Mohr) A pine stump, bears S. 10%° E., 54.0 ft. dist., with pine remains.

A fir, 17 ins. diam., alive & healthy, bears S. 20° E., 16.5 ft. dist., with healed blaze.
