

A fir 29 in. in dia. bears N 60 E, 50 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

A pine 6 in. in dia. bears S 10 W, 19 lks, dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found Basalt stone 12 x 10 x 10 ins. 5 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cormarked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face of stone.

Found fir 31 ins. in dia. bears N 60 E, 50 lks, dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

Found pine 6 in. in dia. bears S 10 W, 19 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set mound of stone about corner stone to the dimensions of 3 feet in dia. and $1\frac{1}{2}$ feet high.

Placed bearing tree tags on both of the bearing trees, with the distance and bearing to the corner, scribed on the tags.

Placed a corner location poster on another tree with the distance and bearing to the corner scribed on the poster.
