Found a mound of earth and stone, with no evidence of a wooden post.


Found Fir 32 ins. dia. being dead, bears S 50 W, 28 feet blazed and scribed 4-352 B.T.

Set 1×30 in. iron pipe with aluminum cap in a mound of stone. Cap being stamped as shown in the above diagram.

Placed Mineral Survey bearing tree tags on the two bearing trees, with the bearing and distance to the corner scribed on the tags.
