
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by W.B. Barr, U.S Deputy Surveyor, under his Contract No. 492, dated August 22, 1383, during April, 1884. The original notes state that at the corner a 16"by 12"by10" marked basalt stone was set 11" in the ground from which:

A 8" fir bears $S10^{\circ}E-74$ lks, marked 1/4S BT. A 8" fir bears $S50^{\circ}W-42$ lks, marked 1/4S BT.



Leland Myers remonumented this corner in 1967.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 30", split, live white fir bears S3°E-48.5' with scribing visible on previously opened blaze.

A reference tag on a 11" pon. pine by Myers bears S53°W-9.43'to nail in tag.

Myers' monument was found bent and lying beside a skid road. The corner monument had been pushed out with a cat. Since Myers had found the original corner stone when he remonumented the corner, his recorded distances to the found bearing tree and the nail in the reference tag were used to reestablish the corner location.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 21" by 30" aluminum pipe with 21" aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried Myers' monument horizontally in the new mound. From the new monument:

A 11" pon. pine bears $$60^{\circ}W-10.2$ ' scribed 1/4 S9 BT. A 9" white fir bears $$17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E-35.7$ ' scribed 1/4 S10 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post South of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

Cap is marked:
T10S R35 E

This corner was remonumented on October 18, 1985.
