## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by W.B. Barr, U.S. Deput y Surveyor, under his Contract No. 492, dated August (22, 1883, during April, 1884. The original notes state that at the corner a 14"by10"by8" marked basalt stone was set 10" in the ground with a stone mound alongside.

## Description of corner evidence found:

A 14"by10"by8" basalt stone, protruding 6" from ground, firmly set and marked "1 on North face.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 14" in the ground to rock and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried corner stone in the new mound. From the new monument:

A 13" pon. pine bears N10½°E-67.9' sc ibed 1/4 S23 BT. A 6" juniper bears S75½°E-35.1' scribed 1/4 S26 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post West of corner and attached sign 54-9. Cap is marked:

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on November 21,1985.
