CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by W.B. Barr, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under his Contract No. 492, dated August 22, 1883, during April, 1884. The original notes state that at the corner a 12"by10"by8" marked basalt stone was set 8" in the ground from which:

R-21 DIAGRAM TIOS R35 E S23 | S24 S26 S2 5

A 12" juniper bears N30°E-52 lks, marked T10S R35 EE S24

A 36" juniper bears S30°E-54 lks, marked T10S R35 E S25 BT.

A 24" juniper bears S80°W-31 lks, marked T10S R35½E S26 BT. A 10" juniper bears N60°W-121 lks, marked T10S R35½E S23 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 13"by8"by6" basalt stone with faint grooves set in a stone mound from which:

A 18" juniper bears N31°E-34.3' with scribing Visible on a partly healed double blaze.

A/42" juniper bears S24 $\frac{10}{2}$ E-35.8' with scribing visible on a partly healed double blaze.

A 26" juniper bears S85°W-21.6' with scribing visible on a partly healed double blaze.

A 14" broken topped, green juniper bears N58 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W-82.1' with scribing visible on a partly healed double blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 8" in the ground to bedrock and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried corner stone in the new mound. From the new monument:

A 26" juniper bears N49 $^{\circ}$ W-70.5' scribed T10S R35 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S23 BT.

New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post North of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on November 21, 1985.
