## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: corner was established as Bonanza Cor. 1, MS 332, during MS 332 survey by Charles M. Foster in December, 1896. The original notes state that at the corner a 42! long by 4" square marked post was set 18" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which:
A 2½' dia. pine tree bears S82 W-24' marked BT-1-332.
A 2½' dia. pine bears S31½ W-16' marked BT-1-332.

During his survey of MS 508, in November, 1902, Horace G. Pearson recovered this corner and established it as Corner No. 2 of the Richmond Lode and Corner No. 2 of the Independence Lode of MS 508. The original notes state that at the corner a 4' above ground by 5" square marked pine post was found from which:
A 18" pine bears N20°E-11.' marked R.2 and I2-508 BT.

The corner was remonumented by James Hambleton in 1967.

## Description of corner evidence found:

See narrative recorded with this corner certificate.

Found Hambletons  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " unflanged iron pipe, protruding 15" from the ground from which:

A 24" burnt pine stump with visible axe marks bears N20°E-11.0' to face of blaze and 11.9' to centerline.

This corner location was confirmed by survey measurements from Bonanza Cor. 4 MS 332.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 20" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried Hambleton's monument horizontally in the new mound. From the new monument:

A 9" pon. pine bears  $568\frac{1}{2}$ ° E-44.3' scribed 1-B-332-2-R-2-I-508 BT. A 15" pon. pine bears  $543\frac{1}{2}$ ° E-73.2' scribed 1-B-332-2-R-2-I-508 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post on National Forest Boundary NE and SE of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts. Cap is marked:

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
