
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was established by Charles M. Foster, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, under MS 332, during December, 1896. The original notes state that at the corner a 4½ long by 4" square marked post was set 18" in the ground with a mound of earth from which:

A 30" white fir bears N34 $\frac{10}{2}$ W-6.5', marked 1-332 BT. A 15" white fir bears N2 30'E-16.5', marked 1-332 BT.

See narrative recorded with this corner certificate.

Description of corner evidence found:

Rotted remains of post at ground level from which:

A 32" white fir bears N9°E-7.6' (record N34 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W) with scribing visible on a partly healed blaze. A root hole bears N45°E-17'+ (record N2°30'E).

A  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " unflanged iron pipe monument by James Hambleton, protruding 14" from the ground, bears S1 $\frac{1}{2}$ OW-10.0'.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed original post remains on the new mound. From the new monument:

A 13" white fir bears N56 $\frac{1}{8}$ °W-78.6' scribed 1-HW-2-E-332 BT. A 9" white fir bears S51 $\frac{1}{8}$ °W-49.0' scribed 1-HW-2-E-332 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary NE and SW of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with  $20^{\circ}\mathrm{E}$  declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on October 31, 1985.
