
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Horace G. Pearson, U.S. Mineral Surveyor, as part of Mineral Survey No. 727, during December 1909. The original notes state that at the corner a 4' long by 6" square marked pine post was set 18" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stone from which:



A 7" pine bears N60°30'W-36.'. A 6" pine bears S29°20'W-27.5'. Both marked N.E. 2-3-727-BT.

In 1967, Hambleton found a mound of stone with rotted remains of post in the middle and remonumented the corner.

Description of corner evidence found:

Hambleton's $1\frac{1}{4}$ " unflanged steel pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap protruding from a stone mound from which:

A 10" dead, standing lodgepole pine bears S31 $\frac{10}{2}$ W-27.6' with scribing visible on an open blaze.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 20" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried Hambleton's monument upside down inside our new monument. From the monument:

A 14" pon. pine bears N52°E-74.8' scribed 2-N-3-E-727 BT.

A 13" western larch bears N16½°E-67.9' scribed 2-N-3-E-727 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary NW and SE of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Cap is marked:

Used steel tape with staff compass with $20^{\circ}\mathrm{E}$ declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on October 11, 1985.
