CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Horace G. Pearson, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, as part of MS 509 Amended, during March, 1903. The original notes state that at the corner a 4½! long by 4" square marked tamarack post was set 18" in the ground from which:

A 16" fir bears S21°30'W-25.'. A 30" fir bears S81°W-28.5'. Each marked D.G.P. 3-509 BT.

This corner was remonumented by Leland Myers in 1967.

Description of corner evidence found:

Myers' 5/8" by 24" iron pin with $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap protruding 4" from a mound of stone. Found remains of original post when digging in new monument. From the monument:

A 45" white fir bears S84 $^{\circ}$ W-29.2' with healed blaze. A 24" dead, white fir snag bears S23 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W-25.5' with scribing visible on a partly healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed Myers' monument inside our new monument and placed original post remains on the new mound. new monument:

A 11" white fir bears \$402°E-37.5' scribed 3-DGP-509AM BT. New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary North and East of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts. Cap is marked:

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on October 17,1985.
