
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Horace G. Pearson, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, as part of MS 508, during November, 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a 4½! long by 5" square fir post was set 18" in the ground from which: ded with

A 18" fir bears N82°W-21.'. A 12" fir bears S36°W-31.'. Each marked P.4-508 BT.

This corner was remonumented by James Hambleton in 1967.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 22" white fir snag bears N82°W-21.0' to face of blaze and 22.1' to centerline with scribing visible on a previously opened bleze.

The corner position was reestablished by measuring record bearing and distance from the found bearing tree, measuring to the face of blaze.

A $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a $1\frac{1}{4}$ " by 30" unflanged iron pipe monument by Hambleton is lying on the hillside below the corner position.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½" by 30" aluminum pipe with 2½" aluminum cap 18" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried Hambleton's monument horizontally in the new mound. From the new monument:

A 8" pon. pine bears $S24\frac{10}{2}$ W-63.2' scribed 4-P-508 BT. A 15" douglas fir bears $N25^{0}$ W-16.9' scribed 4-P-508 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary NE and SE of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20° E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees. 1985. This corner was remonumented on November
