
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established as Haggard Quartz Claim Corner 1, under MS 266A, by Charles M. Foster, in November, 1892. The original notes state that at the corner a marked post was set, from which:

A 2' Fir bears S 76° W - 45', marked: H Qtz. C. Cor 1 BT. H A 20" Pine bears N $18\frac{1}{5}^{\circ}$ W - 15', marked: H Qtz. C. Cor $^{\circ}$ COR4,



In December 1896, under MS 332, Charles Foster recovered the corner and established it as Bonanza Cor. 3, Haggard Cor. 2, Pacific Cor. 2, and Atlantic Cor. 3. The original notes state that at the corner a 4½! long by 4" square marked post was set 18" in the ground with a mound of earth, from which:

Description of corner evidence found:

Atlantic Cor. Pacific Cor. 2 Haggard Cor. 4 Bonanza Cor. 3

Found large mound of earth and original wood post rotted off at ground level, and leaning against a tree stump. Also found more recent sawed square post. Found rotted remains of original post below ground, from which:

A root hole bears S 76° W - 45' +.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stones. Placed found posts on the mound. From the new monument:

A 8" White Fir bears S 5° E - 32.6', scribed: 3-B-2-P-3-A-4-H-332 BT.

A 10" White Fir bears N $72\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W - 29.0', scribed: 3-B-2-P-3-A-4-H-332 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence post on claim line Northeast of corner, and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on October 10, 1985.
