
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established as Corner 4 of the Crown Point Lode, under MS 508, by Horace G. Pearson, U. S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, during November 1902. The original notes state that a $4\frac{1}{2}$ long by 4" square tamarack post was set 18" in the ground, scribed: CP 4-508, from which:



A 8" Fir bears N 49° 30' E. 11.3', blazed and scribed: C.P. 4-508 BT.

A 20" Fir bears N 43° 30' W. 18.5', blazed and scribed: C.P. 4-508 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

The corner has been destroyed by a road. A $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on $1\frac{1}{4}$ " unflanged GIP by Hambleton bears S 71° E - 3.6° , sticking 18" out of the ground. Re-established corner by survey using compass rule method, after rotating record bearings to observed bearings.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone, from which:

A 12" Douglas Fir bears N $49\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E - 41.4', scribed: 4-CP-508 BT.

A 13" Douglas Fir bears S $44\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 58.9', scribed: 4-CP-508 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary South and Northwest of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on	June 4, 1986.	Cap is marked:
