
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established as Corner 2 of the Alaska Lode, Corner 1 of the Protection Lode, and Corner 4 of the Richmond Lode, under MS 508, by Horace G. Pearson, U. S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, during November 1902. The original notes state that a $4\frac{1}{2}$ long by 6" square pine post was set 18" in the ground with mound of earth, marked: A 2-508 and R 4-508 and P 1-508.

This corner was supposedly remonumented by James Hambleton in 1968.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found mound of earth and stone and rotted remains of post at ground level. Also found rotted original post lying above ground next to mound. Surveyed to corner before finding it.

A down $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on $1\frac{1}{4}$ " unflanged GIP, set by Hambleton for the corner bears N 49° 35' E - 27.7'.

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed remains of original post on mound. From the new monument:

A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears S $84\frac{10}{2}$ E - 23.1', scribed: 2-A-1-P-4-R-508 BT.

A 9" Douglas Fir bears N $2\frac{10}{2}$ E - 41.8', scribed: 2-A-1-P-4-R-508 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary Northwest and Southwest of corner, and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with $20^{\,\mathrm{O}}\mathrm{E}$ declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on June 4, 1986.
