
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone, from which:

A 17" Ponderosa Pine bears N 332° E - 16.6', scribed: INT-CP-508-S10-S15 BT.

A 11" Ponderosa Pine bears N $74\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E - 24.6', scribed: INT-CP-508-S10-S15 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary North and East of corner, and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with $20^{\circ}\mathrm{E}$ declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
