Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone, from which:

A 8" White Fir bears N $55\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 54.5', scribed: W 1/16 S10 BT.

A 8" White Fir bears S $76\frac{1}{4}$ ° W - 21.5', scribed: W 1/16 S15 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-9 and 54-3, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary West and North of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with $19^{\circ}E$ declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
