History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Leland Myers in 1967. See Map No. 10S-35 \( \frac{1}{2}E-53 \), and corner certificate.

Description of corner evidence found: Found down monument by Myers. Reset corner position by survey. Based on location poster and scattered rock mound, Myers monument was located very close to corner position by this survey.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 10" in the ground to bedrock and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed Myers monument inside our new monument. From the new monument:

A 16" Douglas Fir bears N  $45\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W - 15.3', scribed: N 1/16 S15 BT.

A 16" Douglas Fir bears S  $83\frac{10}{2}$  E - 37.9', scribed: N 1/16 S14 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary East and South of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with  $19^{\circ}E$  declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
