Description of corner evidence found:

A 2" brass cap on 1" flanged G.I.P. by Myers, marked as shown on corner certificate, was found protruding 6" from the ground S 19 14' W - 16.9' from the corner position determined on this survey. Myers monument was not accepted because of additional original evidence recovered on this survey.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stones, from which:

A 11" Douglas Fir bears N $45\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 34.9', scribed: SE 1/16 S16 BT.

A 14" Douglas Fir bears N $83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E - 13.4', scribed: SE 1/16 S16 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary South and West of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with $19^{\circ}E$ declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
